

AUTHOR'S GUIDELINES

FULL PAPER GUIDELINES

Initially, your submission must meet the requirements for publication in the Proceedings. If selected by our partner journal, you will be notified and advised on which template to follow for the final submission.

To ensure that your paper can be published in the proceedings or the offered opportunities, it is essential that all authors strictly follow the guidelines and formatting instructions for both preparation and submission of all papers.

The proceedings will carry ISBN number and will be submitted for WoS evaluation process.

Papers which do not match the Kautz Conference requirements will be desk-rejected, and authors will not have the opportunity to submit an updated version.

Every submission must contain the authors and affiliation: include the authors' names, affiliation, including university/research institution (faculty/department), country and city, ORCID (every author must provide ORCID ID, for details see: <https://orcid.org/signin>) and email address.

Submitted papers must NOT have been previously published and NOT under review.

The abstract should contain 200-250 words.

A minimum of 3 maximum of 5 keywords is allowed in alphabetical order.

The entire paper (title page, abstract, keywords, main text, figures, tables, appendices, references, etc.), must be in ONE document created in .DOT, .DOC or .DOCX format.

The maximum length of the paper is 16 pages (including ALL tables, appendices, and references). The minimum length of the paper is 8 pages.

The references must be listed in alphabetical order following the APA 7th edition citation style (<https://apastyle.apa.org/instructional-aids/reference-guide.pdf>). It is recommended (not required) to use reference management software e.g. Zotero, Mendeley. <https://www.zotero.org/>, <https://www.mendeley.com/reference-management/reference-manager>

As an overall principle:

- For your abstract you may have up to 250 words.
- For your paper length, the minimum is 8 pages and the maximum is 16 pages.

AUTHOR'S GUIDELINES

- Check that the .DOT, .DOC or DOCX file of your paper is edited correctly and ensure that the file is virus-free.
- Only submissions in English shall be accepted for review.
- In case of acceptance, the author or one of the co-authors should be available to present the paper at the conference. A presenting author¹ can only present one paper at the conference. Only papers presented at the conference are eligible for publication.
- Each paper is limited to one personal appearance (in case of the Early Bird registration the attendance in all programs is free of charge, in case of the normal registration the attendance in conference is free of charge, but the facultative programs and networking events are NOT free of charge) on the program as a presenting author. This policy precludes acceptance of papers for more than one presentation. In other words, an author can submit and present only one paper. However, a presenter can always be a non-presenting co-author on additional papers.
- Authors must ensure that their submitted articles adhere to the following guidelines:

Originality: The submitted article must be an original work of the authors.

Accuracy: The article should not contain any statements or information that are intentionally misleading or inaccurate.

Author Awareness and Contribution: All authors must be fully aware of the article's content before submission. The content should reflect their own contributions, and authorship should be limited to those who have made significant contributions to the work.

Prior Publication: The article should not have been previously published. Exceptions are made for papers previously published at a conference by the authors themselves, provided that the work has been significantly modified and extended to justify inclusion in the Conference Proceedings.

Exclusive Submission: The work presented in the article must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere in any form. Authors should not submit the article for consideration elsewhere while it is under review by the Kautz Conference.

Rights and Permissions: The submitted article must not violate any privacy rights or infringe on any intellectual property rights or other rights of any person or entity. It should not breach any duty of confidentiality owed to a third party and must not contain material or instructions that could cause harm or injury. If any portions of the work are owned or controlled by a third party, permission must be obtained and included with the submission for use in print and online formats.

Conflict of Interest: Authors must disclose any conflicts of interest or declare that there are none.

Margins: left, right, top, bottom: 2.5 cm

File format: .DOT, .DOC or DOCX (**Important:** PDF file format is NOT allowed)

Do NOT add page numbering.

Spacing after: 24 pt

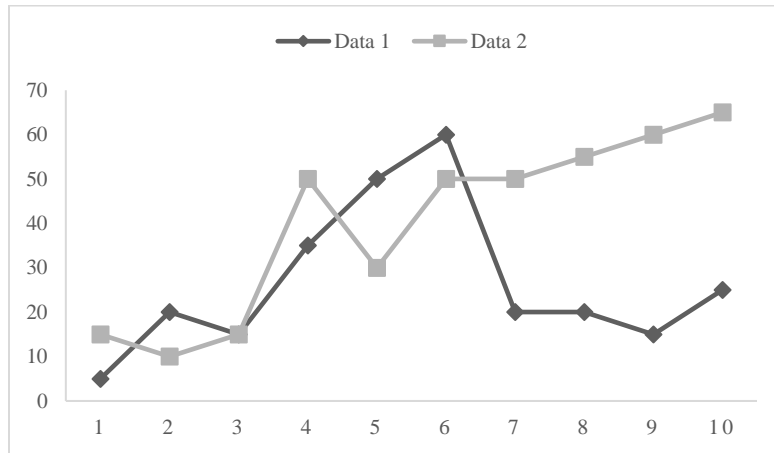


Fig. 1. A figure caption is always placed below the illustration. Short captions are centered, while long captions are justified.
