



## **Publishing Policy**

### **Kautz Conference on Business and Economics 2024**

The aim of the Publishing Policy is to provide ethical guidelines about publishing in the Book of Abstracts and Conference Proceeding.

Authors ensure that the paper submitted is original and prepared to a high scholarly standard. The paper should not have submitted to other conference proceeding or journal before. The corresponding author ensures that he or she can be active during the publishing process and guarantee that coordinate with co-authors about that approval the final submitted version of the paper.

The author's guidelines for abstracts and papers are available on the conference website, implicating a detailed set of requirements, which is important during the publication. The authors comply with the citation ethics.

Submitted papers will be reviewed with a double-blind peer-review process. If the two reviewers support the paper the authors have to make the minor or major revisions and send the paper to the editors. The corresponding author ensures that he or she will be in contact with the editors during the whole publishing process and have to follow the directions of the reviewers and editors and do all of the corrections which are needed for publishing the manuscript.

If there are two rejective reviews the paper is not supported to publish. If only one review is dismissive, editors request a third reviewer, if he or she is supportive the paper can be published. Authors accept that the final decision about the publication is made by the editors.

Authors ensure that they sign the publishing agreement for Book of Abstracts and/or Conference Proceeding.
